RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. This show is affiliated with the Australian Carriage Driving Society. All events are conducted under ACDS regulations with the special conditions of the Midland Agricultural Association Inc excepted.
2. **Drivers to be members of ACDS or an Affiliation of ACDS.**
3. Dress code - For both male and female drivers, it is essential to wear and use a Hat, Gloves, Apron and Whip as they are a traditional part of driving attire.
4. MAA reserves the right to alter the program and prizes if necessary.
5. The MAA reserves the right to change, combine, add or delete classes as required.
6. **The MAA reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning a reason.**

USE OF SHOWGROUNDS INFORMATION:

The 2018 Show will be conducted on the Showground's main arena. To utilise the best part of the arena and to allow sufficient warm up area, only two rings will run.

Parking:

For those staying overnight camping is available next to the Main grounds. Entry is via the Glenelg Street Gate. There is to be **NO** camping on the main grounds, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Day Exhibitors **MUST** utilise the Queen Street (Main) Gates however you must be on site prior to 8.30am. Upon entry via this gate, turn left and park along the edge of the arena adjacent to Queen and Glenelg Streets. Parking for floats is TIGHT so please park as close to other vehicles as is safe to do so. Parking is to be no further south than the first stable block.

No vehicles may enter or exit whilst the show is in progress - this is an insurance requirement.

Ground Entry:

Exhibitors will be required to pay entry fee at the gate. **Members** are entitled to a Member and Member's Guest entry, as well as children's passes.

***Stabling Bond:** Refundable when stables are found to be left emptied. This will be documented on your stable card. Failure to leave stable as required will result in bond being non-refundable.
