SHOW JUMPING COMPETITION

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. This show is affiliated with the Equestrian Australia. All events are conducted under EA regulations with the special conditions of the Midland Agricultural Association Inc excepted.
2. Riders to be members of either Equestrian Tas, or an Affiliation of ET ie Showjumping, Eventing or PCAT.
3. Dress Code – Article 256 Formal Dress or Pony Club uniform.
4. Current standard safety helmets **MUST** be worn.
5. Jumping will be conducted under current FEI/EA rules for jumping. **All events are non graded.** Please read guidelines for each class.
6. Regional Schools event, rider must be in either primary or secondary.
7. MAA reserves the right to alter the program and prizes if necessary.
8. The MAA reserves the right to change, combine, add or delete classes as required.
9. Doping and cruelty clauses will apply. Random swabbing may occur.
10. Draw order of jumping will be available after close of entries.
11. **Enter TWO Classes ONLY (this may include 1 championship class per horse). Depending on numbers, classes may be divided into 2 sections.**
12. **To compete in jumping events horses MUST BE 4YRS of age.**
13. *The MAA reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning a reason.*

(Article 238.2.1)

This is a competition against the clock, athletes with equality of Penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties and time taken for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course.

(Article 238.2.2)

This is a competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other athletes are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.
